Tsunami Warning Exercise at HLSCC ...head to the hills



The HLSCC community recently participated in a TSUNAMI simulation exercise to aid in their continued planning for disaster preparedness. Earthquake and tsunami events occurring in and around the Virgin Islands are monitored by the West Coast Alaska Tsunami Warning Centre and the Puerto Rico Seismic Network (PRSN).

These organisations provide notification to the DDM in the event that any earthquake or tsunami is recorded, based on a well-defined protocol. PRSN, through an agreement with the Government of the Virgin Islands, has installed a number of seismic stations and strong motion sensors throughout the Territory. They monitor and maintain these units and have provided significant resources and technical support to the DDM for many years now.

At HLSCC a draft Emergency Management Plan is under review, which will serve as a guide for various hazards/disasters that can affect the College at any given time. These exercises are critical in order to minimize the loss of life and property.

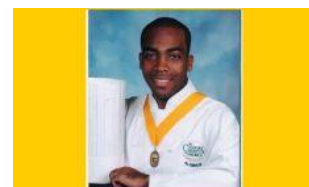
