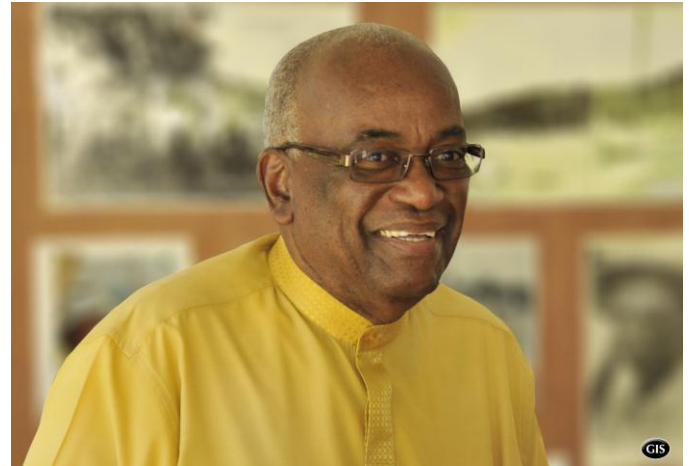
Save the Date: The survey will be launched on March 6th


Everyone is encouraged to take part in the survey as we seek to find out where we are as an organisation.

STUDENTS RECOGNISED FOR ACHIEVEMENTS

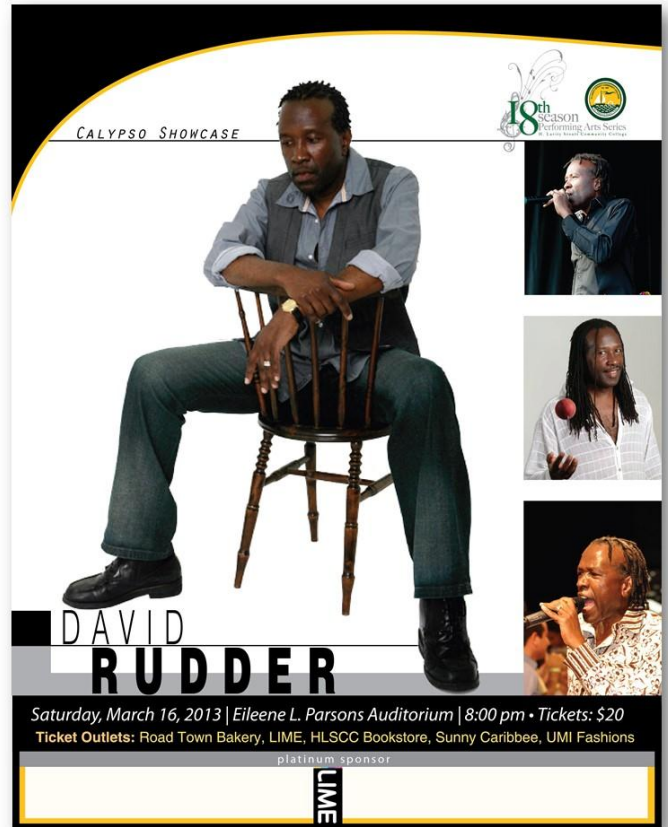

CALYPSO SHOWCASE... Featuring David Rudder



David Rudder was born in Belmont, Trinidad on May 6, 1953. One of 5 children, he spent much of his early childhood with his grandmother, a spiritual Baptist. He grew up near a pan yard and a Shango yard in a neighborhood where boys dreamed of being entertainers.

Rudder began singing at the age of 11 with a group called The Solutions. In 1977, he joined a brass band called Charlie's Roots and the rest is history. His musical tastes in the past have leaned towards jazz, blues, folk rock and the African sounds of Youssou N'Dour, Salif Keita, Mory Kante, and Alpha Bondy. Rudder, who also paints, sees himself more as an artist than an entertainer. His work has become legendary in Trinidad and Tobago around the region and internationally.
